Although for Bright Futures, the 29 or 1290 ACT/SAT score isn't required of AICE Diploma recipients, scores in the 90th percentile do help our students gain entrance into the most competitive universities; therefore, we will be stressing the importance of working to bring up ACT and SAT scores. In January all our students in grades 8-11 will receive their most recent College Board PSAT results from the October exam next week. We'll convene a Knight's Club meeting to distribute the paper copies and double check and make sure all students are have SAT & Khan linked and understand how to access their personal learning path. Khan creates a customized path of remediation and practice based on weak areas on the PSAT/SAT. Seniors already have scores from last year and are already linked and working in Khan.
